Activities of 2017-18

ASMITA Education Program in Slums.

We had 16 Non Formal Education Centers in 16 slums of Varanasi. Every center is taken care by one each teacher. They take 3 hours class and activities with the children and one hour for visiting the families. The Name of the teachers and the slums are given here below;

ASMITA Tailoring Centers



We had two Tailoring centers. One was in Kadipur and another in ASMITA Hall at Sagra. In each center there were 30 girls each. This program aims at making self reliant community by the girls. We have also enrolled their name into the Pradan Mantri Kaushal Yogana.

ASMITA Community Health Program



We had two each health camps in every month in various slums of Varanasi. A part time doctor has been leading the medical camp, Co-Ordinated by Sr. Uttama SRA. In this camp doctor first listens the problems of the area then he speaks about some preventive methods as well as First Aid for any illness.

ASMITA Rainbows

Under the title of ASMITA Rainbows we were helping eight orphan or semi orphan children for their education. Total expenses of their education is met by ASMITA.

ASMITA Mazdoor Suraksha Yojana-MSY

For the social security of the unorganized labour class ASMITA has taken up the government pension scheme under the banner of the CBCI labour commission called Mazdoor Suraksha Yojana. ASMITA has enrolled about 150 people in it. This year we have renewed 9 of them.

ASMITA Inter Religious Program



ASMITA regularly organizes or participate in various inter religious activities.

**ASMITA Pradanmantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana**

Under the Pradhanmantri Kaushal Yojana ASMITA conducted two programs. In one program ASMITA provided certificate for 145 girls who knew tailoring. In another program we had two tailoring centers in which we had four months of class for 60 girls. Among them 56 girls wrote exam and all passed and provided certificate of Pradhanmantri Kaushal Yojana.
